National Board Examination Pass Rate Statistics for First-Time Takers

As of January 1, 2004, each accredited program in funeral service education must require each student take the National Board Examination as a requirement for graduation. Students are not required to pass the exam, only to take it. Each program must post the most recent three-year average score of first-time takers on the entire NBE exam on their website. Programs must maintain at least a 60% annual student pass rate of first-time takers on the National Board Exam.

The annual passage rate of first-time takers on the National Board Examination (NBE) for the most recent period for this institution and all ABFSE accredited funeral service education programs is posted on the ABFSE web site: <http://www.abfse.org/html/dir-listing.html>.
